



## WuduMate Classic Cleaning and Maintenance Recommendations

- The WuduMate Classic is made from high-quality sanitary grade acrylic, and should be cleaned and maintained in a similar way to acrylic items found in the home, such as baths and shower trays.
- Cleaning should be undertaken with normal NON-SCOURING (i.e. non- abrasive) cleaning agent or detergents and a soft sponge or cloth.
- In areas of hard water, lime-scale can be removed by using normal NON-SCOURING household lime-scale removers as can be found in a number of household detergents.
- Scratches can be removed in the same way as they are removed from the bodywork of motor cars, using T-Cut scratch removers, finished with liquid polish. To recreate a shine, once the unit is free of grease/dirt/lime-scale, polish thoroughly with T-Cut, and/or a fine sandpaper - 600 grit or higher.
- If over time neglect causes the WuduMate to lose its gloss, the original shine can be largely (if not fully) recreated by buffing/polishing with a dry cloth, or mechanised drill based polisher or buffer.
